Experience luxurious rail travel aboard the classic 1930's Pullman car *Dover Harbor*—traveling to **Chicago, IL**.

Your trip starts on **Tuesday, May 28th** with an afternoon departure from **New York, NY** with the **Lake Shore Limited**, a train that *Dover Harbor* traveled when operating in Pullman's heyday. Enjoy cocktails and hors d'oeuvres as we travel up the **gorgeous Hudson River**. Dinner will be served after departing Albany as we head west on the **ex-NYC Water Level Route**. Later, snuggle into your **authentic Pullman berth** for the overnight trip across Ohio. Awake to a freshly prepared breakfast prior to our mid-morning arrival at **Chicago's Union Station**. You'll have more than five full days to enjoy this magnificent city's sights including the **Lakefront/Navy Pier, Museum of Science and Industry, the Magnificent Mile, art museums** and much more! And railfans, make your way to Pullman on June 1 & 2 to enjoy the **Historic Pullman Railroad Days** festivities—*Dover Harbor* will be there!

Then on **June 4th**, *Dover Harbor* takes leave of Chicago departing in the evening with the **eastbound Cardinal**. As the sun fades, enjoy dinner, socialize in the lounge, read, play cards, and relax before retiring to your Pullman berth. By morning, you'll be traveling through the **scenic mountains of West Virginia**. Savor **brunch** as the train heads eastward into the **New River Gorge**. The scenery continues across the **Blue Ridge into Virginia**. An early **dinner** will be served prior to the early evening arrival in **Washington, DC**. After a race up the **Northeast Corridor** *Dover Harbor* will make a late-night return to **New York**.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All passengers may enjoy the comforts of *Dover Harbor's* lounge. En route sleeping accommodations are *Dover Harbor's* classic Pullman bedrooms, which sleep two persons in an upper and lower berth. Each room has a washbasin and toilet; a shared shower is available to all overnight passengers.

CONDITIONS:

1. The Washington D.C. Chapter, NRHS makes every effort to accommodate the physically challenged; however, Dover Harbor as a historic railroad car is not wheelchair accessible. Operator requires those physically challenged passengers requiring special assistance from others to travel with someone who is able to assist them.
2. Those with special dietary needs such as food allergies or vegetarian/vegan meals must notify the reservations agent in writing at least two weeks in advance of the trip.
3. **No refund or credit of purchased tickets after April 15, 2024** other than by operator's cancellation of the trip or reselling of the space. The operator suggests passengers obtain trip insurance to cover cancellations resulting from personal emergencies, illness or other causes.
4. Package does not include hotel accommodations, gratuities, personal incidental charges, tours, admissions, local transportation or meals. No meals or overnight accommodations are included except enroute aboard *Dover Harbor* as described above.
5. Fares are per person, double occupancy. Single spaces may be purchased at double occupancy fares; however, shared accommodations will be assigned at the discretion of the reservations agent.
6. The General Conditions for tours, trips, excursions, and events as published on the DCNRHS web site (www.dcnrhs.org) apply. By making a reservation, participants agree to be bound by both the General and these specific Conditions.
