Niagara Falls Escape

Saturday, October 5, 2024 to Tuesday, October 8, 2024

Escape to one of the natural wonders of the world—Niagara Falls—in 1930's luxury and comfort aboard the *Dover Harbor*, a restored Pullman Railroad car. You'll view the New York State scenery, at the time of year when Jack Frost begins to paint Autumn's colors along our route.

This rail trip departs mid-morning on Saturday, October 5th from New York's Moynihan Train Hall traverses the scenic ex-New York Central Water Level Route along the Palisades of the Hudson River. At Albany, our route turns westward across New York State following the bucolic Mohawk River Valley. On the way, you'll enjoy a sumptuous lunch at midday, and dinner prior to our late evening arrival. In Niagara Falls, stay at a hotel of your choosing (not included).

You'll have **two full days**-- Sunday and Monday-- in Niagara Falls free to sightsee as you wish. The focal attractions are the **American and Horseshoe Falls**, over which flow between 350,000 to 750,000 gallons of water per second. View them from the several observation points above or ride the **Maid of the Mist** and see them from below. Learn about the area's natural and local history at the **Niagara Falls Gorge Discovery Center**. Or book a sightseeing tour for all the highlights!

For more adventure, cross the Rainbow Bridge into Canada (don't forget your passport!) and see the pretty views from Oakes Gardens and Queen Victoria Park, or get a high angle view from the 360-degree Skylon Tower. Consider the Whirlpool Aero Car, Whitewater Walk, and if you're really adventurous, a helicopter ride over the Falls.

After your two fun-filled days, be ready for the early morning departure on Tuesday, October 8th for our return trip. Following departure, breakfast with morning restoratives will be served. A bit later enjoy lunch before our mid-afternoon arrival in New York.

For our Washington DC area members and friends, this trip is scheduled so you can easily make same day connections on your own in New York to or from our trip via regularly scheduled Amtrak Northeast trains from Washington.
