Join the Washington, D.C. Chapter, NRHS for a three-hour walking tour of Amtrak's Ivy City Washington DC shop complex. Participants will have a behind-the-scenes tour of the shop complex facilities. See routine how maintenance and repairs are made to Amtrak passenger cars and locomotives. Learn about Amtrak initiatives to improve the rail experience. Today more than 63 trains originate or terminate each day out of the **Ivy City** shop complex. This is a walking tour of a railroad facility on hard and gravel surfaces so proper, comfortable shoes are needed.

Tour participants will meet in the **Employees parking** lot adjacent to the shop complex at **1:15pm** and then will be led to the appropriate shop entrance to begin the tour promptly at 1:30pm. Directions for **free parking** will be provided to tour participants with tour instructions.

For this tour, children must be at least 12 years old, accompanied by an adult and pay the same fares as adults.



CONDITIONS

This tour is of an active Amtrak facility which is not normally open to the public. Tour participants must be able to stand for times in places without seating, transit over rails, walk over gravel and hard surfaces, and some climbing may be required. Areas of the tour may not be accessible. Operator requires those physically challenged individuals requiring special assistance to be accompanied by someone who is able to assist them.
- 3. All participants must be dressed appropriately, wearing closed, hard soled shoes (no flip flops, sandals, open shoes, athletic shoes/sneakers or high heels permitted). Participants not properly dressed will be denied entrance; no refund will be provided.
- 4. Children above age 12 are welcome on this tour, however each child must be supervised by an accompanying adult. There is no separate child's fare.
- 5. Photography is generally permitted on this tour; however, photography of certain areas, equipment or employees may be restricted by Amtrak hosts during the tour.
