Experience **Pullman travel**, aboard the Washington, DC Chapter's historic rail car, *Dover Harbor*, on a trip to New Orleans. You'll see varied scenery as *Dover Harbor* travels with **Amtrak's** *Crescent* on an arc across the South from **Washington DC through Atlanta to New Orleans** with a changing mix of passengers just as it was in Pullman's heyday.

The adventure begins at **Union Station** in the early evening on Thursday, July 10th with the departure Amtrak's southbound *Crescent*. Visit with your fellow passengers while savoring cocktails and dinner prior to a night's slumber in a **classic Pullman double bedroom**. The next morning, begin the day with Georgia scenery and breakfast.

At Atlanta's Peachtree Station day passengers may board for a scheduled departure at 9:08AM on Friday, July 11th as the car comes southbound with Amtrak's *Crescent*. As the train travels through the Deep South, nosh on lunch, and later, a freshly prepared dinner by our chef and served by your Pullman porter. Your train sails across Lake Ponchartrain to an evening arrival in New Orleans—where the delights of this trip's terminus await for you to explore.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All passengers may enjoy the comforts of *Dover Harbor*'s lounge. En route sleeping accommodations for overnight passengers are *Dover Harbor*'s classic Pullman bedrooms, which sleep two persons in an upper and lower berth. Each room has a washbasin and toilet; a shared shower is available to all overnight passengers. PER PERSON FARES (FIRST CLASS)

All fares include one-way travel on *Dover Harbor* including snacks, onboard meals, beverages, wines and spirits while en route. ALL FARES ARE PER PERSON for the listed occupancy.

1. The Washington D.C. Chapter, NRHS makes every effort to accommodate the physically challenged; however, Dover Harbor as a historic railroad car <u>is not wheelchair accessible</u>. Operator requires those physically challenged passengers requiring special assistance from others to travel with someone who is able to assist them.

2. Those with special dietary needs such as food allergies or vegetarian /vegan meals must notify the reservations agent at least two weeks in advance of the trip. Please include a note in the comments line when placing your order or send an email to reservations@dcnrhs.org.

3. No refund or credit of purchased reservations after June 15, 2025 other than by operator's cancellation of the trip or reselling of the space. The operator suggests passengers obtain trip insurance to cover cancellations resulting from personal emergencies, illness or other causes.
