

Amtrak Ivy City Shop Tour

Saturday, April 25, 2026, 10:00AM or 1:30PM

Join the Washington, D.C. Chapter, NRHS for a two and a half hour walking tour of Amtrak's Ivy City Washington DC shop complex. Participants will have a behind-the-scenes tour of the shop complex facilities. See how **routine maintenance and repairs** are made to Amtrak passenger cars and locomotives. Learn about Amtrak initiatives to improve the rail experience. Today more than 63 trains originate or terminate each day out of the Ivy City shop complex. This is a **walking tour** of a railroad facility on hard and gravel surfaces so proper, comfortable shoes are needed.

CONDITIONS

1. No refund or credit, other than by operator's cancellation of the trip or reselling of the space. Reservations are not transferable and may not be resold without the consent of the operator.
2. The Washington DC Chapter NRHS makes every effort to accommodate the physically challenged; please discuss your needs with the DCNRHS reservations agent. This tour is of an active Amtrak facility which is not normally open to the public. Tour participants must be able to stand for times in places without seating, transit over rails, walk over gravel and hard surfaces, and some climbing may be required. Areas of the tour may not be accessible. Operator requires those physically challenged individuals requiring special assistance to be accompanied by someone who is able to assist them.
3. All participants must be dressed appropriately, wearing closed, hard-soled shoes (no flip flops, sandals, open shoes, athletic shoes/sneakers or high heels permitted). Participants not properly dressed will be denied entrance; no refund will be provided.
4. Children age 12 or older are welcome on this tour, however each child must be supervised by an accompanying adult. There is no separate child's fare.
5. Photography is generally permitted on this tour; however, photography of certain areas, equipment or employees may be restricted by Amtrak hosts during the tour.
6. The General Conditions for tours, trips, excursions and events as published on the DCNRHS web site (www.dcnrhs.org) apply. By making a reservation, participants agree to be bound by both the General and these specific Conditions.
