

# Metro Dulles Shop Tour

## Saturday, June 13, 2026

Join the Washington, D.C. Chapter, NRHS for a one and a half hour walking tour of Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's (Metro) Dulles VA shop complex. Participants will have a behind-the-scenes tour of the Metro's newest shop facilities serving the Silver Line. See how **routine maintenance and repairs** are made to transit vehicles and about transit authority initiatives to improve transit car availability and reliability. This is a prolonged **walking tour** of a transit maintenance facility on hard and gravel surfaces so proper, comfortable closed toe shoes are needed.

Tour participants will meet at the **shop front door at 9:15am** and then will enter the shop to begin the tour promptly at 9:30am. Driving directions for **free parking** will be provided to tour participants with tour instructions. Please note, the Metro Dulles Shop cannot be accessed via Metro or public transit.

### CONDITIONS

1. No refund or credit after May 13, 2026, other than by operator's cancellation of the trip or reselling of the space. Reservations are not transferable and may not be resold without the consent of the operator.
2. The Washington DC Chapter NRHS makes every effort to accommodate the physically challenged; please discuss your needs with the DCNRHS reservations agent. This tour is of an active WMATA facility which is not normally open to the public. Tour participants must be able to stand for times in places without seating, transit over rails, walk over gravel and hard surfaces, and some climbing may be required. Areas of the tour may not be accessible. Operator requires those physically challenged individuals requiring special assistance to be accompanied by someone who is able to assist them.
3. All participants must be dressed appropriately, wearing closed, hard-soled shoes (no flip flops, sandals, open shoes, athletic shoes/sneakers or high heels permitted). Participants not properly dressed will be denied entrance; no refund will be provided.
4. Children above age 12 are welcome on this tour, however each child must be supervised by an accompanying adult. There is no separate child's fare.
5. **Due to WMATA requirements, photography is prohibited on this tour and cell phones may not be brought into the shop.**
