

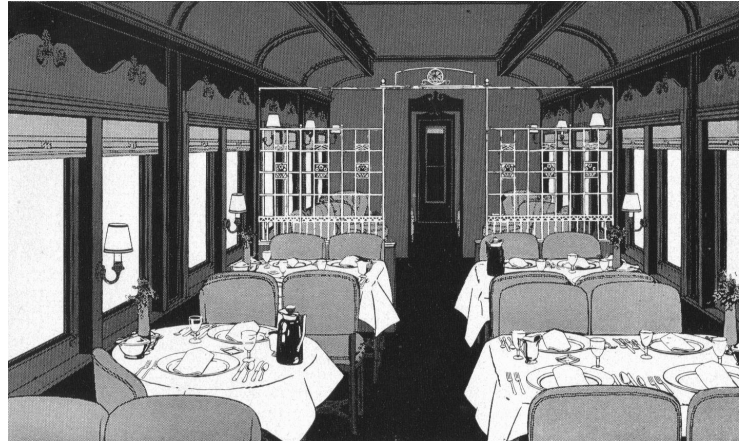
Dinner on the *Dover*!

We're revisiting our rail heritage this special evening with dishes inspired by those served on the **fabled name trains** of the past-- think the *Capitol Limited*, the *Broadway Limited*, the *Southern Crescent*, or the *George Washington*. Just like on the **dining cars** on those trains, your **three-course meal** will be prepared aboard the *Dover Harbor* and served by **uniformed stewards**. From appetizer to dessert and coffee, enjoy the **delicious food** and **polished service** the *Dover Harbor* is known for. A selection of wines, beer and cocktails will accompany your meal. It's certain to be an evening to remember, and **you are cordially invited**.
